

How To Measure A Spa For A Replacement Cover

Tools Required: Tape Measure & Carpenters Framing Square


Step 1

First, use the tape measure to measure the outside length and width of the spa, as shown below. You may want to place a piece of wood vertically at each of the two outside edges, and measure between the two. This will make it easier to find the true outside edge. Use page 2 of this document, to record and submit your measurements. Please record all measurements in inches.



Step 2


Place the Carpenters Framing Square on the corner of the spa. The inch marking on the framing square where the framing square first makes contact with the spa, tells you the radius of the corner. If the framing square first makes contact at the 6 inch mark, the radius of the corner is 6 inches. In the event that the first place that makes contact is at a fraction of an inch, 5 & ½ inches for example, always round down to closest inch.
